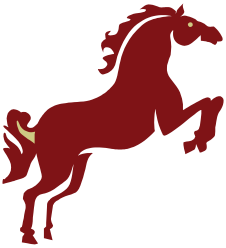

Minutes of Meeting

**Call to Order**

**President's Comments**

President Kiblinger read the following statement:

*"It has been brought to our attention that we neglected to name a nominating committee for the election of the POA board members for this upcoming term.*

*During one of our board meetings, it was stated that we did not need to form an actual committee as only one person was leaving the board and we already had that office filled. We all agreed and selected our choice for the vacating Vice Presidency and for the vacated office of member-at-large to present to the POA members 30 days before the election. In essence the Board became the nominating committee.*

*In so doing, are there any nominations from the floor?"*
